Question as to what is needed – everything, so bring some cleaning supplies, and if you want a bucket and mop or sponges or something, bring it.

- Radio stations – Betty will make sure the word gets out to the radio stations as a PSA
- Volunteers – shifts will be 1 hr shifts, from 13-1400, 14-1500, 15-1600, 16-1700. At LEAST 1 BS & GS leader at the booth at all times, more would be GREAT. NO MONEY will be collected. For the GS, info will go to the Trp Organizer. For BS info, family will be informed of the Pack area's of responsibility, or of the Troops available. Uniform is Class A for your organization (scouts too)
- Need to emphasize POST Venture crew
- Camps -
- GS – No Go on the twin ridges 14-18 JUL Day camp. JUN camp is still a GO
- BS – 18-21 JUN
- CS Day Camp -
- The camp out will be on FRIDAY not on Thursday for the webelos (or families). Arapaho did not express interest in getting a bus and adding the Post Flag Day ceremonies to the morning, so Knox participants can go to camp after the ceremony is complete.
- Planning for Spring Jamboree 04 - We still need a list of the activities that the GS would like to offer during the event next year, to see how we could accomplish this on post, and what resources would be needed (Training Area for camping, range, rappel tower, stables, etc). Need a POC on this event. The GS present stated that they would get this on the agenda to be discussed at the next GS SVC Unit meeting.
- Memorial Day – John Signorino (or Mindy in the unlikely event that John is TDY) is the POC for this event. All scouts (Girl, Cub, Boy, and Venture) will be placing flags at the Post Cemetery for Memorial Day. Class A uniform, Friday, 22 MAY 03 at 1600 (or as soon as you can be there, since some scouts are just getting off of the bus at that time) at the Fort Knox Post (St Patricks) Cemetery. Event was moved from the Monday to the Thursday so that the flags could be out over the weekend when families come to visit the cemetery.
- Flag Day at USAREC –
- Is Friday, 13 JUN 03, during Cub Scout Camp. We will retire 2 flags.
- Will need at least 12 scouts. Would like to have at least 1 Boy / Cub / Venture Scout from Every Troop and Pack as well as at least 1 GS from each rank level to participate in the Flag Retirement ceremony. We will need names, and phone numbers for ceremony volunteers, ASAP, as USAREC will want to rehearse prior to the ceremony. Will request the rehearsals be after 1600 to allow camp activities during the day.
