WELCOME TO GIRL SCOUTING

Registering as an individual member is an alternative to being registered as a member of a troop or group. An individually Registered Girl ("JULIETTE"), in partnership with a parent, other adult relative or friend, plans her own program using the available Girl Scout resources. How much or how little she chooses to do is up to her and, of course, her parent/ adult partner who guides her.

Here's a brief overview of what's available to a JULIETTE.

THE BIG PICTURE...



Girl Scouting begins in the community but it is a world-wide movement. Over two million girls throughout the United States are having fun as Girl Scouts planning and doing activities like earning badges, creating crafts, exploring careers and learning about themselves and the world around them. Beyond the U.S., Girl Scouting and Girl Guiding reaches more than 100 countries all over the world.

The Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio Council, one of over 300 councils in the United States, serves Girl Scouts who live in San Bernardino and Riverside counties. Each council is a member of Girl Scouts of the USA, a national organization and in turn GSUSA is a member of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS), a world-wide organization.

The \$7.00 membership fee provides membership with Girl Scouts of the USA for one year (Oct-Sept.). 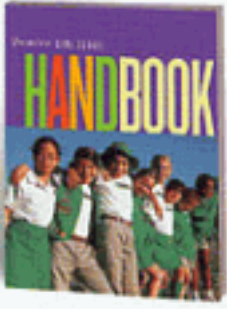

AGE-LEVEL HANDBOOKS

The Girl Scout handbook for each program age level is an important resource. Each book contains an overview of the Girl Scout program, activities and requirements for Badges, Try-Its or Interest Project Patches as well as information on "Bridging" (moving up) to the next program age level. These resources, along with others, are available through the council shop (information on back).

GIRL SCOUT RECOGNITIONS

A Girl Scout Recognition is something that is earned by completing a certain number of activities. The patch or badge symbolizes that the girl has accomplished a new skill or talent. As an Individually Registered Girl Scout, there may be times when activities will need to be adapted to fit the situation. For example, a requirement may ask a girl to share something with her troop. In that case, a "JULIETTE" would be encouraged to share with a group of friends, her school class, etc. Recognitions may be purchased through the council shop.



COUNCIL PROGRAM EVENTS/ACTIVITIES

In addition to the activities in the Girl Scout handbooks, program events are organized by Girl Scouts of San Geronio Council. Opportunities for camping, arts/crafts, leadership development, career exploration and much more are available year round. Program booklets outlining these events are mailed to girls twice a year (refer to *Individually Registered Girls* in the "How to Register" section of the book). COUNCIL PRODUCT SALES

Individually Registered Girl Scouts are eligible to participate in both council product sales and earn the incentives. To participate, please contact the Council Product Sale Coordinator in September/October for QSP/Nuts/Calendar Sale and January/February for the Girl Scout Cookie Sale.

UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA

Girl Scouts may be identified by members of Girl Scouts of the USA by their Membership Pin. The Girl Scout Membership Pin is worn on the left side, above the heart. The Girl Scout uniform is a privilege of membership, symbolizes being part of a special group and provides a link with other girls involved in Girl Scouts. Girls are encouraged to wear the uniform that has been designed for their age level, however it is not required. Insignia are badges, pins and special identification that you wear on your uniform. See the Girl Scout Handbook or contact the Girl Scout shop for more information.
